His areas of clinical research have included melanoma, basal cell carcinoma, Merkel cell carcinoma, and kidney cancers. Dr. Cowey is the co-director of the Baylor Charles A. Sammons Cancer Center Skin Cancer Treatment and Research Center. He also serves as the chair for the melanoma committee for the Sarah Cannon Research Institute and is active in the American Society of Clinical Oncologists and the Southwest Oncology Group.
