Research Interest

Dr. Teneriello was the chairman of the gynecologic research committee for The US Oncology Network for 12 years. He has served as a principal investigator for US Oncology Research, a lead institution in the NCI sponsored cooperative group, NRG Oncology. He has conducted more than 50 clinical cancer trials in Austin as the national or local principal investigator and is extensively published in the field of gynecologic oncology.

Medical Practice

Dr. Teneriello is a graduate of Dartmouth College and the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai in New York, NY. He later completed residency training in obstetrics and gynecology at the National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, MD and fellowship training in gynecologic oncology at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington DC and the National Cancer Institute in Bethesda, MD. After training, Dr. Teneriello served as an obstetrician/gynecologist at the Naval Hospital in Yokosuka, Japan and later as the director of gynecologic oncology at Walter Reed Army Medical and Allegheny General Hospital in Pittsburgh, PA.

In 1996 he was recruited as the first gynecologic oncologist to join the Austin practice of Texas Oncology. Dr. Teneriello practices the full range of gynecologic oncology and helped develop and maintain a robust clinical research program. Dr. Teneriello has actively participated in the
